The exhibition of Palestine in Kyoto of Haitham Khatib at Kyoto Museum for World Peace, Ritsumeikan University was from April 28th to May 20th in 2018.

When you hear someone say “Palestine”, you may think they are having a religious war with Israel, or they are terrorists, and/or it’s far away and has nothing to do with you. Many of us may have these impressions of Palestine. However, many Palestinian people say
 “We love peace, family and freedom like everyone else, so please learn about the harsh conditions we have been living under for all these many years. Our freedom and human rights have been taken from us by force. We ask that you share this with your family, your friends and with as many people as you can”.

We usually think that we have no relationship or responsibility for a conflict or war in a distant foreign country, and that we are innocent people. But it could be that are impressions are wrong, that we are misinformed and are actually contributing indirectly to the pain and trauma in the Middle East.

We hope this exhibition helps everyone who visits it to come to know the real situation of Palestine and Israel, and will appeal to other “innocent” people to do the same.

Haitham Khatib is from Bil'in, Palestine (west bank) is a freelance photographer and
