Al Aqaba is a village in Jordan valley, just situated near an Israeli military training ground.

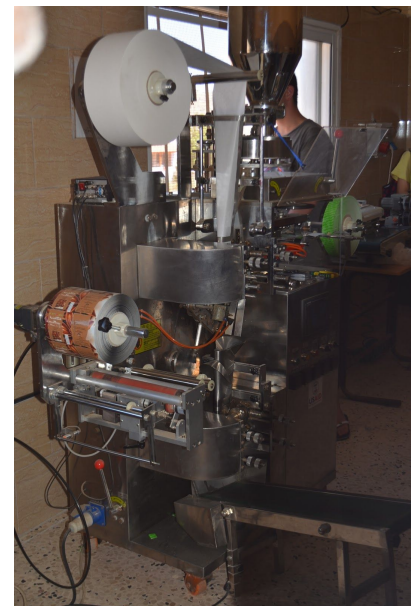
The village was destroyed 40 years ago by the Israeli military.

Despite the difficult situation, Haj Sami, the major of Al Aqaba, has succeeded in building up the village again and to found an agricultural cooperative, a school and a kindergarten, a mosque, a public house, a women's project and more things for the village.

The Earth Caravan is supporting a project for tea production of the agricultural cooperative there. 40 families live from producing tea for the cooperative.
